### Legal Update: July 22, 2024

A 2021 Colorado bill, HB21-1110, requires that **ALL** school district technology, hardware, and software, including public-facing and internal-facing technology, must comply with specific accessibility standards to ensure individuals with disabilities can access district resources and services. Technology that must be accessible includes third party tools, websites, applications, kiosks, digital signage, documents, video, and audio. **Districts were required to comply with the new accessibility requirements by July 1, 2024, but there is a one-year grace period from liability as long as districts can prove they are making a good faith effort toward compliance and resolving any complaints.**

District's grace period to adhere to these requirements will conclude on July 1, 2025.
